## **Cumberland Medical Transport**

(Ambulance owner)

- Leased Stacy Garland from Mountain **Health Services**
- · Relied on Mountain Health Services to perform Human Resources functions
- · Was not privy to her medical history



#### **Mountain Health Services** (staffing company)

- Responsible for all Human Resources functions for EMTs and other staff it leased
- · Guaranteed that staff it leased to Cumberland would be qualified for the position they were leased to fill
- Sent potential employees to Smithville Medical Center for Pre-Employment Health Screening



#### **Smithville Medical Center** (Hospital that conducted screening)

- Personnel performing Pre-Employment Health Screening not properly trained
- Pre-Employment Health Screening Form inadequate
- Smithville personnel failed to appreciate significance of information provided





## Kingdom Fire & Casualty Co.

(Insurer of Ambulance Owner)

- Sued by Mountain Health Services and Smithville Medical Center for coverage for claims arising from Ambulance accident
- Countersued Mountain Health Services and Smithville Medical Center to recover money it paid to settle personal injury claims arising from Ambulance accident


# Hospital where Garland sought treatment for syncopal episodes


- Garland came there after fainting while driving one month before her hire
- · Repeated syncopal episodes
- · Never definitively diagnosed the cause
- · Never determined treatment to control
- · Failed to instruct her not to drive











# **Dr. Jarvis Tannen**Garland's Primary Care Physician

- Had information that she was either employed or entering employment as an ambulance driver
- Was aware of several ER and hospital visits for syncope, undiagnosed and untreated
- · Never advised her not to drive
