Size of the Service:

► 30,635 Fire Departments

- Half dozen members to 10,000 Village to Metropolitan Area 12% career or mostly career 88% volunteer or mostly volunteer Fierce Independence – to a fault
- ► 47,100 Fire Stations

Size of the Service:

- ▶ 1.2M firefighters
- ► Career firefighters protect most of the population Volunteer firefighters protect most of the area
- 121,228 NREMT Certified
 Portion of the total service
- ► 40,000+ ambulances
